Job Summary

The purpose of the B-Operator (Pit Operator) position is to operate the Pit and associated pumping systems in a safe and efficient manner, in accordance with Pit Operating Procedures. The Pit operator is directly responsible for Pit Recovery and consistently pumping stable rates and high percent solids to the plant. Responsible for supporting a variety of general labor taskings. The position performs a variety of duties such as fire watch, confined space entry watch, painting, washing, shoveling, janitorial, or other labor duties as needed in support of other operating and maintenance teams. This position will perform physical labor including loading, unloading, lifting, and moving supplies and materials. May also assist in operational activities, operations and maintenance training, fabrication, assembly, and installation of equipment under close supervision. B-Operators are expected to train and become qualified for A-Operator positions.
